## **Secretary General's Report**

Dear members

Welcome to the 14<sup>th</sup> annual national conference 'APCRICON 2012' at Kolkata from 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> July 2012. Our theme this year "Towards a Sustainable Rabies Control Programme in India – An One Health Initiative." is timely and will bear the torch for our activities in the coming years.

Time has come for us to join hands with other national organizations in public health like the Indian Public Health Association (IPHA) and IAPSM.
